



Davie PAL Learning POD

The Davie PAL Learning POD will be a place where parents can drop their kids off so that they may go to work, while their children take their classes online. There will be a total of 30 kids in the program and we will be using the community room and computer lab for this program (see seating chart attached). We will follow the Broward School Boards proposed schedule from July 23 and follow any changes that they institute. See Guidelines page attached for safety protocol and rules of the program. All participants will be required to sign a Hold Harmless Waiver that is attached to this packet. This program will go for nine weeks from the first day of school and we will reevaluate as we get closer to that time line.



GUIDELINES FOR SCHOOL ASSISTANCE AND BOXING PROGRAM

All participants will be required to sign a waiver before being allowed into the program

Participants- All participants arriving to the PAL will wait outside until they are met by a staff member, where their temperature will be taken. Any participant showing a high temp., fever, cough, sneezing, or illness of any kind will not be admitted in to the Davie PAL. If at any time during the day a child is showing signs of not feeling well, they will be isolated from the rest of the children and their parent will be called and required to pick them up. All participants will then proceed to the bathroom where they will be required to wash their hands. This process will be done throughout the day.

Parents -At no time will parents be allowed to enter the Davie PAL. They will remain outside where a staff member will check their child in for the day and or check them out.

Staff, Coaches, Volunteers- All staff, coaches, and volunteers will have their temperature taken prior to starting their day. If any of them show signs of a high temp, fever, cough, sneezing or illness of any kind they will be sent home. All Staff, Coaches, and Volunteers will minimize contact between participants and will be required to wear a mask while at work, and gloves if they so desire. These items will be provided by the Davie PAL.

School Assistance Program- Will have a schedule of 8-5pm allowing parents to get back to work. The students will be dropped off at 7:30am and in a classroom setting from 8-2pm. The students will be working with their teachers online and following the schedule that the school has assigned to them (SEE ATTACHED). The students will sit two to a table 6ft apart from each other with a total of not more than 30 kids in the program. We will utilize our community room and our computer lab (for students having technology issues they may use our computers) for this program. Students will break for lunch that will be provided by PAL or they may bring their own. They will sit in their same seat for lunch and will wash their hands immediately after lunch is over. After 2pm, the students will be taken outside (weather permitting) in the gymnasium if weather is bad, and will play for the remainder of the day. Water station will be set up outside and when breaking between activities (lesson, lunch, outdoor, indoors) students will be required to wash their hands. All staff and volunteers will be required to wear a mask while at work, and if they desire, gloves will be provided. **Staff will sanitize all equipment and rooms in the building used by participants with our sanitizing machine each day.**

Boxing- Only existing members will be admitted to the program. Boxing will follow the same schedule as in the past and training will resume as normal with the exception of sparring. There will be no sparring in the gym until we deem it is safe to go back to that practice. **After each boxing training day, the coaches will sanitize all equipment used by participants, with our sanitizing machine.** Coaches and Volunteers will be required to wear a mask while at work, and if they desire to, gloves will be provided.
